Springs Ranch Elementary

School Overview - Springs Ranch Elementary School is located in Eastern El Paso County in School District 49. Our school has approximately 540 students ranging from Preschool age through fifth grade. Springs Ranch is a comprehensive neighborhood school that is student-focused, offering a strong academic foundation and well-rounded program of enrichment opportunities and character development. Springs Ranch serves a diverse population of students and families with a variety of socioeconomic statuses and cultural backgrounds. We serve a wide range of students including those with special needs through a broad spectrum of services and programs. Additionally, Springs Ranch offers programs in culturally/linguistically diverse and gifted education. Springs Ranch Elementary School is dedicated to supporting each child to reach their fullest potential by providing an equitable and inclusive atmosphere. We offer a rich menu of before and after school programs to our students, enhancing our ability to educate the whole child. At Springs Ranch Elementary, students are inspired to collaborate, learn, and grow through learning opportunities that allow students to achieve mastery at different paces, paths, and places. All students receive instruction in the core content areas of ELA, math, science, and social studies. Additionally, all students participate in Art, Music and PE classes.

Springs Ranch Elementary is rated by the Colorado Department of Education as a "Performance" school as we are categorized as "meet" in Academic Achievement and "Approaching" in Academic Growth on the School Performance Framework.

Assessment Participation - Springs Ranch met the state assessment participation rate as more than 95% (+98%) of our students participated in taking the 2019 CMAS assessments in ELA, Math, and Science.

Process and Stakeholder Involvement - Springs Ranch Elementary School Building Leadership Team (BLT) reviews current and trend data to determine major improvement targets. Current data, progress towards prior year's performance targets, prioritization of performance challenges were first reviewed by the Springs Ranch Leadership Team. This group of professionals consists of General Education teachers from each grade level, Special Education teacher, Specialist teacher, Literacy Coach, Assistant Principal and the Principal. As a team, we initially met to analyze data, identify needs and challenges, and to isolate root causes. The Leadership Team members shared the information with their grade level teammates during Collaborative Planning Team (CPT's) meetings. From there, grade level teams and individual teachers analyzed achievement data to identify trends, patterns and specific needs. Teams then identified curriculum and instructional needs, trends, and possible root causes. Furthermore, representatives of the BLT met with SAC to share results. The Leadership team meets quarterly with the SAC to review our school-wide Plan. The SAC reviewed the final improvement plan for the 2020-2021 school year on September 15, 2021.

Springs Ranch Elementary School has demonstrated achievement in the "performance" range with inconsistent growth on the CMAS test for the last three years this assessment was given. We have "met" achievement targets for all subgroups with the following exceptions: English learners and students with disabilities for ELA, as well as students with disabilities for Math. In academic growth, students were "approaching" for ELA, with "does not meet" for minority students. Springs Ranch "met" academic growth in Math, with free/reduced lunch and minority students in the "approaching" category. Our local assessment data for ELA indicates similar progress and achievement. Additionally, our Acadience Reading scores indicated high percentages of students at benchmark or higher across most grade levels.

On our annual culture and climate survey, students have opportunity to rate various statements on a 1-5 scale (5 being positive agreement). Students at Springs Ranch rated "My teacher cares about me" as their highest agreement score with a score of 4.73. The lowest rating with a score of 3.84 was "Students show respect for each other at this school."

2) Culture and Climate - All staff members need to continue to develop the capacity to build relationships with students and create learner-centered cultures within all classrooms.

These root causes were examined and verified by assessment data and perception data, with input from the building leadership team, and reviewed by the School Accountability Committee (SAC).





Data collected using the Comparing Measures Composite Score to determine the percentage of students At or Above Grade Level in Reading


