Therefore, the pilot will take place in the fall of 2020, and purchasing of the CDE approved core will take place in winter of the 2020-2021. The CDE approved core will be fully implemented during the 2020-2021 school year.

To address the COVID-19 crisis, we will give teachers a month to settle into our new instructional model which will include blended learning. Since the approved list did not until May, which was during the COVID-19 crisis, we will have to wait until the fall to pilot, which pushes back our implementation. However, we will have a CDE approved core implemented prior to the end of the 2020-2021 school year.
