Implementing Allowable Activities

Harrison School District 2 will use the READ funds at the school level in grades K-3 at each of the 13 elementary schools in the District. The use of the funds will be for targeted evidence based reading interventions, reading interventionists, technology, and reading coaches who will complete job embedded professional development to teachers of reading. The interventions will be provided to students who show that they have an SRD based on Accadience screener and confirmed by the DIBELS Deep diagnostic assessment. Interventions will be targeted to meet student's individual needs. In addition, some schools are purchasing reading interventionists to monitor and deliver the interventions to students. Some schools are purchasing technology, including software, that will be used to deliver the reading interventions and support core instruction and assessments. Reading coaches are present at all schools, some supported through READ funds, to provide professional development and support to our core reading teachers and reading interventionists.

Outcomes and Goals

What are your LEP's expected outcomes and goals in the upcoming budget year from implementing your selected allowable activity(ies)?

Our goal is to reduce the number of students with an SRD by 50% from the BOY testing window to the EOY testing window through strong core instruction delivered by teachers with an understanding of the science of reading, targeted interventions based on students' needs and progress monitoring to assess student growth and ensure on target students do not fall behind.

Potential Barriers

What are potential barriers in reaching your expected outcomes and goals? How do you plan to address and/or overcome these barriers?

A large percentage of students in our district come to us with an SRD starting in kindergarten. While we close the gap for some students, far too many continue with an SRD throughout the grade level. The district is focusing next year on ensuring that all kindergarten students are reading at or above grade level. By having all students in the benchmark or above range, we can continue that success with a first grade focus in the subsequent year.
