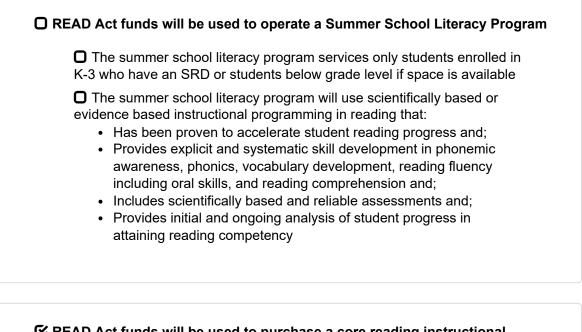

Adopt and implement a new reading curriuculum through Amplify, CKLA, which is researched based and systematic to create uniformity of instruction and increased phonemic skill sets.

Increase FTE by .25 for our elementary reading interventionist to adequately implement intervention strategies for students within both the well-below and below benchmarked areas as identified within assessment and progress montioring tools. Ensure professional development is aligned to improve data comprehension and effective use of student data to guide instruction and intervention practices, instructional fidelity, use of technology to increase data dialog and aligned assessment practices.

Outcomes and Goals

What are your LEP's expected outcomes and goals in the upcoming budget year from implementing your selected allowable activity(ies)?

Cotopaxi School District's expected outcome and goals for the upcoming year will be to increase all well-below benchmark(red) and below benchmark (yellow) students reading skills growth by 50% from the beginning of year to the end of year. Through implementation of an aligned and researched based curriculum and intervention program, increased data comprehension and data application, instructional training, and aligned assessment practices student growth is expected.

Potential Barriers

What are potential barriers in reaching your expected outcomes and goals? How do you plan to address and/or overcome these barriers?

The first barrier towards our outcomes and goals relates to the uncertainty centered around COVID-19 and direct impact to instruction design and student equity. However as a small district, we are working deligently to align scheduling, resources and best practices within the guidance still evolving from the State. Internally, a couple of additional barriers are being addressed to include staff comprehensive understanding and effective alignment of data to guide instruction and interventions targeted towards student deficiencies. Scheduling can also impede growth therefore protecting intervention time is a priority. Finally, aligned professional development and PLC time to ensure cohesive communication and implementation practices as well as fidelity to instruction.
