The Akron School District plans to use READ Act funds to purchase intervention services focused on increasing student's foundational reading skills using a scientifically based intervention program that has been approved by CDE. This trained paraprofessional will work in a small group of children grades kindergarten-3rd grade that have been identified as having a reading deficiency.

Outcomes and Goals

What are your LEP's expected outcomes and goals in the upcoming budget year from implementing your selected allowable activity(ies)?

The District expects the students on READ plans to improve their reading scores due to the data-driven strategic intervention, small group support they receive from the tutor. The teacher and paraprofessional will determine the adjustments needed to the student's READ plan as needed to increase/decrease time, intensity, learning strategies, or other interventions as needed throughout the year. DIBELS and NWEA assessments will be utilized throughout the year to monitor the student's progress.

Potential Barriers

A potential barrier is students who were already academically behind due to socioeconomic factors, likely will have fallen even further behind during online instruction during the Covid-19 pandemic.
