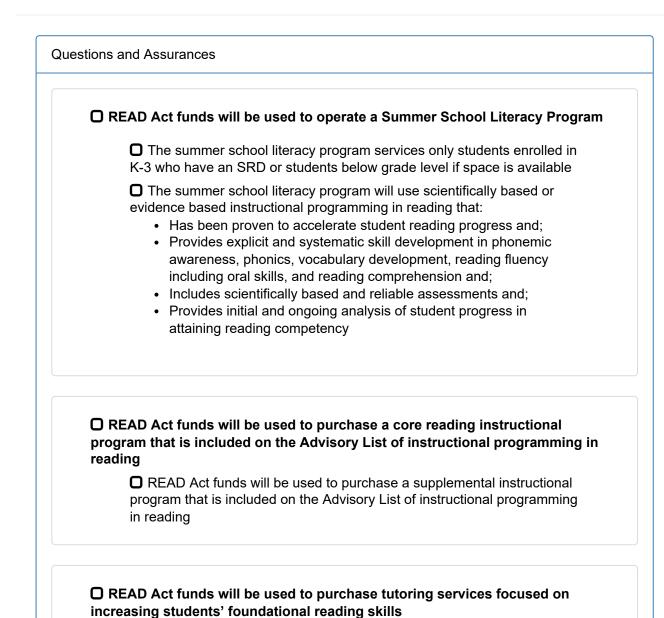

To address and overcome these barriers, we plan to purchase and implement, through the use of Resource Room Classroom Aides, a targeted, science based intervention program, Burst.
