Westminster Public Schools will be utilizing READ funds in the following manner in 2021-2022: 1. Continued hiring of two reading specialists who will be full time employees of the district. Both have been trained in the science of reading (LETRS) and will work with young teachers to improve their instructional craft at the Tier 1 level as well as assist with reading data analysis and Tier 2 supports. 2. Continued implementation of LETRS training. New teachers will complete Units 1-4 this fall while veteran teachers will begin Units 5-8 this fall to continue on our trajectory of all K-5 staff completing LETRS Units 1-4 by January 2022 (or demonstrating competency in another CDE-approved manner). 3. The district will continue to support the purchase of Tier 2 and 3 reading interventions such as Lexia and CR Success. 4. The district will support the Reading Partners intervention program at Orchard Park K-8 and Harris Park Elementary 5. The district will continue to support the partial salary of an administrator to oversee the READ act rollout. 6. The district will support the summer reading academy at Fairview Elementary School in the summer of 2022 (was funded out of a private grant in 2021).
