However, we do purchase additional materials such as LETRS, FAST, BLAST, FOUNDATIONS, PALS, and NWEA to maximize growth/achievement of all students. All materials are on the Advisory List of Programming. 3. Other Services: RE-1 Valley uses READ funds to partially fund K-3 literacy coaches and instructional coaches to assure student growth/achievement in all classrooms.
