This teacher will provide scientifically-based interventions to all students who qualify for READ services. These interventions will be intensive in nature and focus on closing identified reading gaps. These interventions will be provided in addition to reading instruction that all students receive in the general education classroom. Students are identified and monitored through the bi-weekly use of Dibels. The interventionist utilizes Really Great Reading programs, Ortin Gillingham, and Haggerty at grades k-3 to support student learning and close the gap.
