Our plans to use the READ Act funds are to implement a Summer School Program. We would like to pay our summer school administrator \$1000.00 for planning, organizing, and implementing our summer school program. We pay our teachers \$35.00 an hour for summer school, with the READ funds we will have enough for 186 hours. The rest of the budget will be spent to cover employee benefits for the summer school program. We use Acadience Reading, and STAR Early Learning for our interim assessment. For our core program we use Houghton Mifflin, and for our supplemental program we use Lindamood-Bell/Seeing Stars. We will use all these programs in our summer school program. Our district MTSS team monitors progress of students who are reading below grade-level and ensure that in-class supports are provided and monitored for effectiveness. Our special education team implements reading-focused IEP accommodations and modification with fidelity. Our students who are below grade-level are invited to our summer school program.
