Weld Re-3J will be using Read Act funds to pay for .46 FTE who will serve as a foundational reading and core curriculum implementation specialist. This person will provide ongoing (bi-weekly) teacher professional development to ensure high-quality implementation of our core reading program, CKLA, and Wit & Wisdom. This position will partner with principals, classroom teachers, literacy interventionists, and other special service providers to plan and teach CKLA and Wit & Wisdom lessons to their intended fidelity. The .46 FTE will prioritize time that is focused on planning alongside teachers, observing reading lessons being taught, and provide ongoing feedback in a coaching capacity. We will also use Read Act funds to purchase CDE approved supplemental and intervention programming (Really Great Reading Blast, Countdown, HD Word, and Istation Early Reading) in the amount of \$15,000 to be used by classroom teachers and reading interventionists.
