The LEP will utilize the Reading Interventionist/READ Plan coordinator to support the accurate testing of students, development and review of student READ Plan goals, initiate communication with parents about student progress, and coordinate reporting data. In addition, the Reading Interventionists/READ Plan coordinator will support teachers in the implementation of student read plans by supporting their planning and implementation of Wonders (2023) instructional strategies. The Reading Interventionist will provide supplemental reading support for students in individual and small group settings throughout the year using the Wonder (2023) core reading program.
