We have approximately 5-6 trained tutors. Our assistant principal and lead interventionist train and manage the tutoring program. We use only approved programming for tutoring. We use the READ money for our Summer School program. Our principal manages the program and we use an extension of our core reading curriculum and intervention materials with our K-3 students who are on an SRD. Students are invited to the program based on their current SRD. Lastly, we will use the funds to purchase additional intervention and core curriculum materials which are on the approved list. Those materials include SIPPS and Into Reading materials.
